



### 1. RAILWAY LINE AND ZONE

- It is forbidden to cross the railway line at any place other than a designated safe crossing.
- Before crossing the line, always make sure there is no approaching train or shunting locomotives.
- Moving and staying in the railway zone are only permitted with the approval of the responsible person.
- It is forbidden to climb onto wagons or intermodal transport units.
- Traffic signs and instructions from terminal staff must be strictly observed.



### 2. WORKING MACHINES AND MANOEUVRING ZONE

- It is forbidden to move under a lifted load.
- Keep a safe distance from working machines (reach stacker, container crane, forklift, other machines and equipment).
- Entry to the active terminal yard is only with the operator's permission.
- Operator's instructions and traffic signs must be strictly followed.
- Pedestrians must use the designated walkways and marked safety zones.



### 3. PARKING

- Parking is prohibited outside designated areas.
- After parking, the vehicle must be secured (handbrake applied, engine switched off and key removed).
- The 20 km/h speed limit must be observed.



### 4. HGV TRAFFIC LANES

- Goods vehicles must use the designated traffic lanes.
- All traffic signs and instructions from authorised personnel must be respected, especially the speed limit.
- Overtaking is prohibited.
- Seatbelts must be worn at all times.
- Vehicles may not be left unattended.



### 5. PEDESTRIAN MOVEMENT

- Only the designated pedestrian walkways may be used.
- High-visibility reflective vests must be worn throughout your stay at the terminal.
- The use of a mobile phone is prohibited when moving in the administrative and customs building area and the transshipment (manoeuvring) and storage yard.
- Extra caution is required at junctions and when passing vehicles, machinery and equipment.



### 6. FIRE PROTECTION

- Smoking is prohibited outside designated areas.
- Open flames may not be brought in or used.
- Stopping and blocking access to firefighting facilities and equipment is prohibited.
- Any fire or smoke must be reported to the responsible personnel



### 7. EMERGENCIES

- Accidents, fires or danger, must be immediately reported to terminal staff.
- Follow the evacuation plan and the instructions of the responsible staff.
- Emergency numbers are available at the entrance and on the information boards in the terminal..



### 8. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- High-visibility vest, safety footwear and other PPE must be worn.
- PPE must be used in accordance with the instructions and its intended purpose.
- Failure to use PPE correctly may result in a ban from the terminal.



### 9. OBLIGATIONS OF VISITORS AND DRIVERS

- All rules and instructions from the terminal staff must be respected.
- Visitors and drivers must sign in with the security officer at the entrance, and drivers of goods vehicles must also sign in at the Intermodal Terminal dispatcher's desk.
- Staying in the work zones is only permitted when approved.
- Failure to comply with the rules may result in removal from the terminal and further legal action.



### 10. DRESS CODE

- Entry to the terminal is prohibited in shorts, vest tops, slippers and with pets.



### 11. VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

- The premises are under constant video surveillance.



### 12. OTHER PROHIBITIONS

- Possession of firearms or cold weapons is prohibited.
- Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or psychoactive substances is prohibited.
- Recording and photography is prohibited.
